

PAT'S INTERVENTION AT THE CONFERENCE UNION FOR ETHICAL BIOTRADE 2018 "BEAUTY OF SOURCING WITH RESPECT"

Plant Advanced Technologies PAT announces its intervention at the 10th edition of the Union for Ethical BioTrade (UEBT) biodiversity conference which will take place on 19 and 20 June at the Paris Marriott Champs-Elysées hotel.

Every year in Paris, companies from the beauty, food and pharmaceutical sectors gather for UEBT's Beauty of Sourcing with Respect conference to discuss consumer demand for natural and ethical ingredients. In 2018, discussions will focus on research and development of new natural substances and sharing of benefits with countries, local and indigenous communities at the origin of plant resources.

On this occasion Prof. Frédéric Bourgaud, PAT research vice-president, and Dr. Lydia Genthon, in charge of biodiversity, will present the industrial technologies used at PAT to produce active ingredients by root exudation from plants grown in aeroponic horticultural greenhouses. Plant resource preservation is at the core of the technology and presents a break with traditional cultivation or harvesting practices. A concrete example of economic development in the DOM-TOM through PAT Zerbaz, a subsidiary of PAT on the Reunion Island, will be highlighted.
